

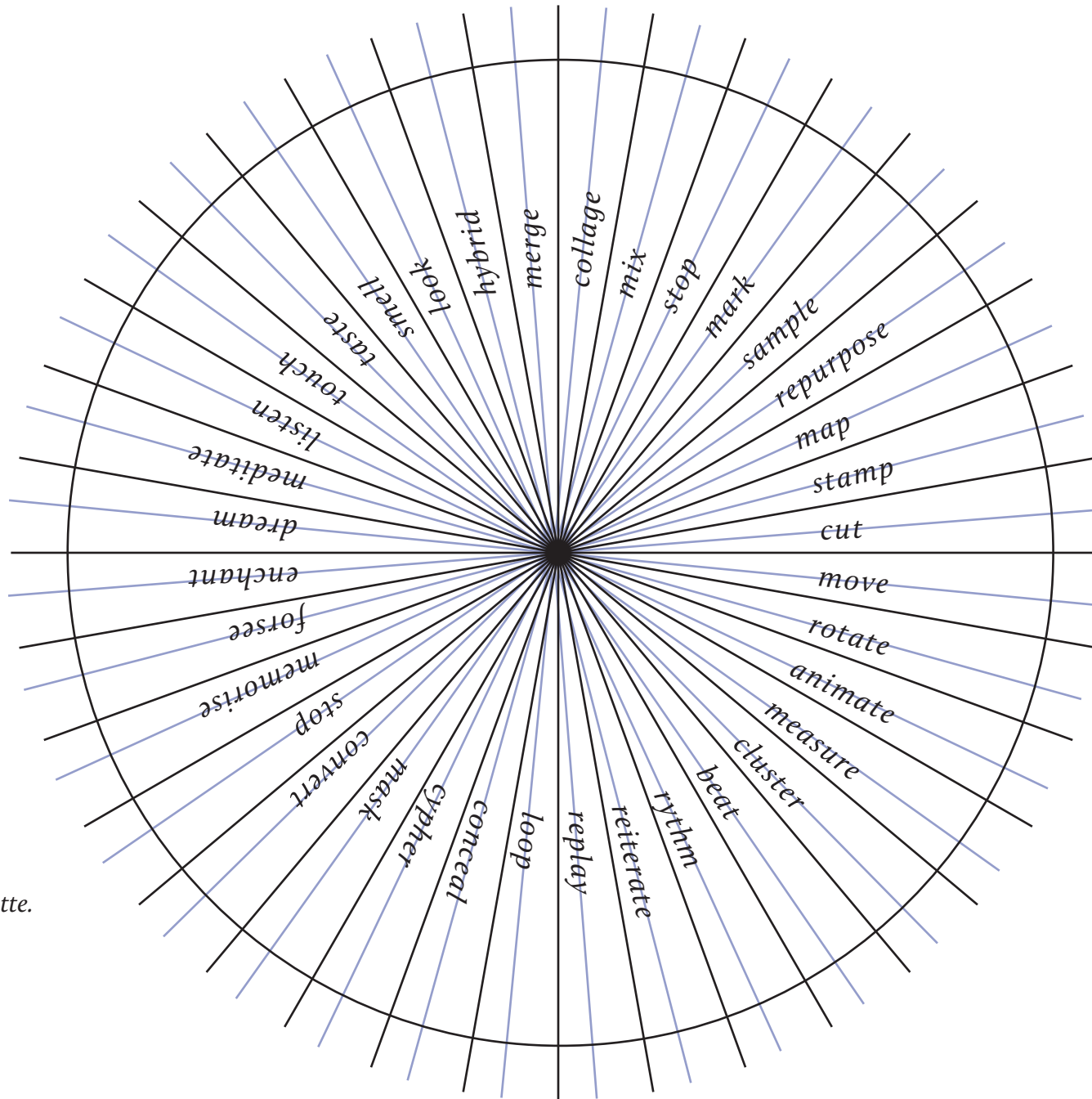
# Art Roulette

cut out and spin

## Instructions:

Prepare two pieces of cardboard 20x20 cm.  
Print the pdf.  
Cut out the circle representing Art Roulette.  
Write down chosen actions in the empty fields.  
Redraw it on the first piece of cardboard.  
Cut out the circle from the cardboard.  
Paste the Art Roulette on the circle cut out from the cardboard.  
Fasten the circle to the second piece of the cardboard using a drawing pin.  
Place the pin in the middle of the circle.  
Do it loosely.  
Now you can spin the roulette.  
Mark an arrow or a dot on the rectangular



According to TVC taxonomy of Nettrice R. Gaskins

*Art roulette is a tool that can be helpful during art classes or different artistic undertakings. It proposes a series of randomly generated actions to apply to the visual artwork, object, or text. The tool provokes us to expand our usual practices. It can be used in a group or to create a joint artwork in a playful way.*

*The idea is inspired by the TVC taxonomy diagram published in Nettrice R. Gaskins's work "Techno-Vernacular Creativity and Innovation across the African Diaspora and Global South." The author analyses vernacular strategies for approaching technology. These strategies subvert existing politics of technology that favor material and intellectual resources.*

*The author claims that "technologies are not mere tools that we use, but active forces in the world."*

# Art Roulette

cut out and spin

## Instructions:

Prepare two pieces  
of cardboard 20x20 cm.

Print the pdf.

Cut out the circle  
representing Art Roulette.

Write down chosen  
actions in the empty fields.

Redraw it on the first  
piece of cardboard.

Cut out the circle  
from the cardboard

Paste the Art Roulette  
on the circle cut out  
from the cardboard.

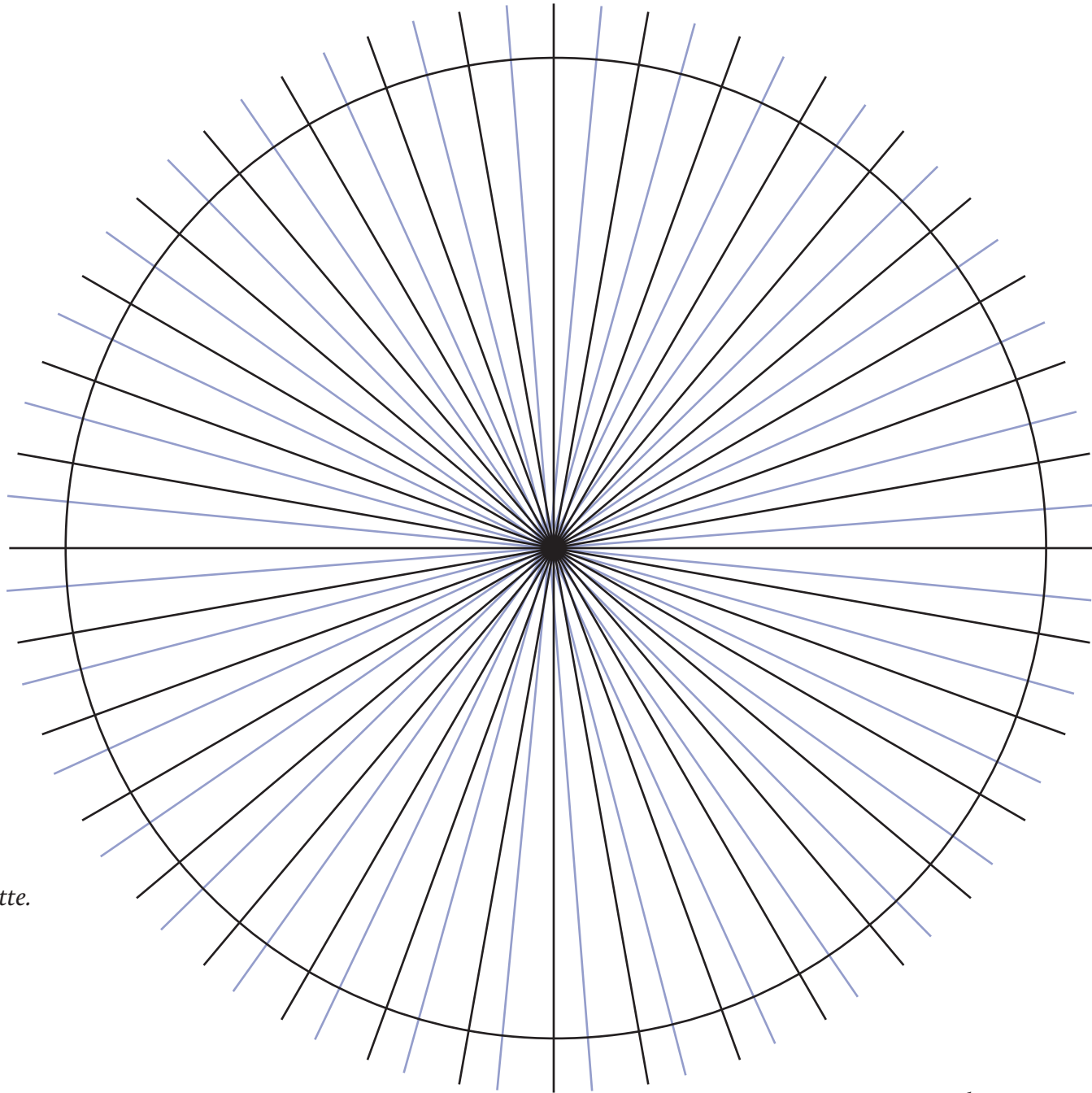
Fasten the circle

Do it loosely.

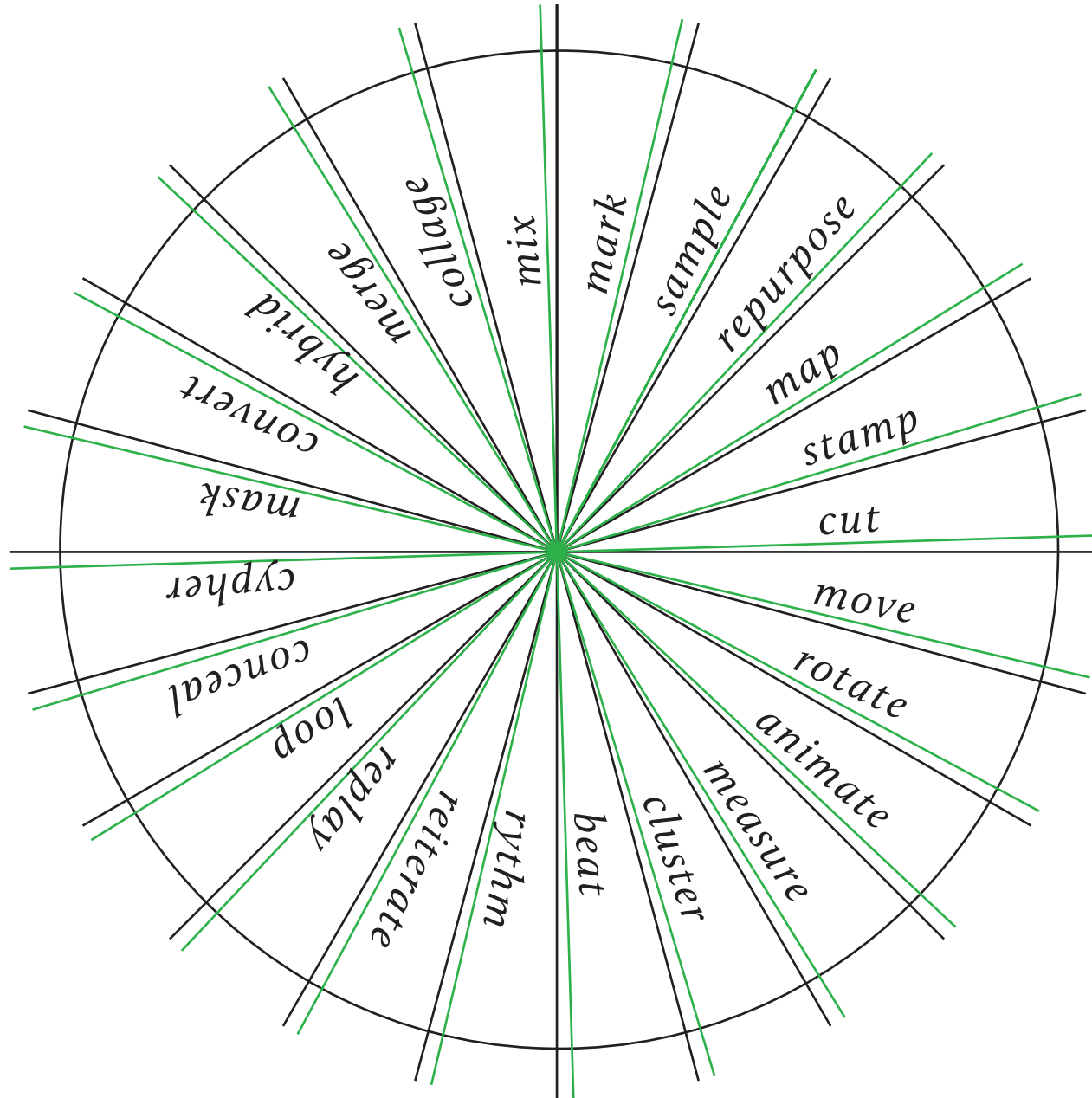
Now you can spin the roulette.

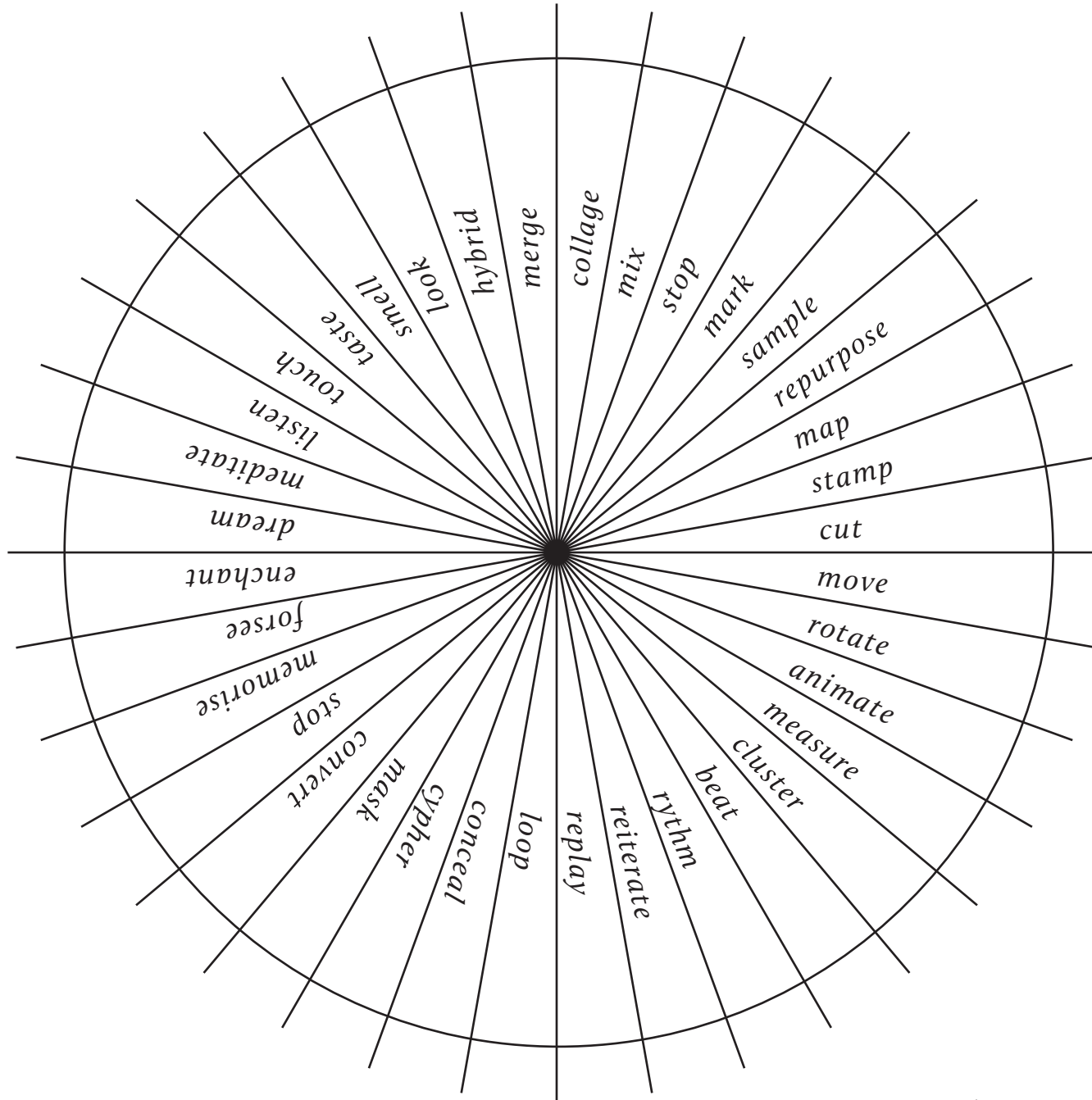
